- GC and AB introduced the formation and purpose of MAPC outlining its evolution from previous volunteering structures. The council will ensure alignment with strategic objectives and improve communication to IPEM members.
- Draft Terms of Reference were reviewed with minor amendments recommended
- RMcD proposed a scoring and decision matrix to be published to enhance transparency, addressing perceptions of exclusivity. The Council agreed.
- The Council discussed maintaining two-way communication with SIG's and committees, recognising the need for representation and balancing this with their workload. A SIG Rep on a rotational basis of 12 months was agreed.
- The Council discussed the status and management of Task & Finish Groups, including implementing requirements for regular updates and agree on criteria for closing groups that show no progress. Future Task & Finish Group requests need to be aligned to strategic priorities for approval.
- The Council discussed the identification and refinement of IPEM's strategic priorities and the need for representation beyond the NHS. It was recommended to revisit previous member engagement events for outputs, suggesting the inclusion of Academic, Industry, Sustainability and Professional Registration for Engineers.
