- MAPC noted strong progress against priorities in Clinical Engineering, the Heads of Medical Physics and Clinical Engineering network, MRT dosimetry, strategic regulation, and non-medical referrer training.
- Further work is still needed on modular training, workforce priorities, and engagement with NHS England/National School on more flexible training pathways.
- MAPC supported a joined-up approach to RWA/RPA/MPE certification and HSST alignment to avoid duplication and improve accessibility across sectors and specialties.
- EPSC reported progress on the Clinical Technologist Education and Career Framework and IPEM's planned role as the national DEXA training provider.
- STEC's revised Task and Finish Group process was welcomed and will be reviewed in December for possible wider application.
- MAPC supported preparing a concise future strategic direction thought piece for December, informed by previous work and wider consultation.
